The school is a nut-free site, **please do not bring any kinds of nuts onto the premises.**

Parking

There are approximately 100 spaces onsite, accessed via gates 1 and 4 from Trumpington Road. See site plan as well as your personal booking information for which gate to use.

Gates will be open and attended before the workshop starts and at the finish each day. If you need to come and go between these times, entrance through the gates is via a keycode: **1998**

Please park considerately. Vehicles left onsite at owner's risk.

Sports hall

Please bring light soled shoes to wear in the hall. We have been asked to protect the courts by only placing chairs around the perimeter.



Dining

Meals will be taken in Ashburton hall (a site plan will be sent with your booking confirmation). If the weather is nice you are welcome to eat outside at the picnic tables.

Please ensure all litter is collected and any spills (even outside) are cleared up.

Water will be available but you may want to bring your own bottle.

Accommodation

Shared rooms have been booked at the nearby Travelodge (Cambridge Leisure Park, Clifton Way, Cambridge, CB1 7DY) approximately 1 mile from the school. Breakfast is included, please eat at the hotel before making your way to the school.

There are limited parking spaces behind the hotel, available at £12 per day (you will need to book this *yourself* in advance), but there are plenty more in the adjacent multi-storey car park, at £7 per day if you ask the hotel staff to validate your parking ticket.

Breakfast will *not* be available at the school so if you have booked your own accommodation you will need to make arrangements for your own breakfast too.

Transport

From Stansted there are excellent train and bus links. For trains visit www.thetrainline.com, off-peak return fares are £15.60 and trains run every 30 minutes until 8pm. Cambridge train station is a little over 1 mile from the venue and less than 1 mile from the hotel.
