WHEREAS *Today, Fung Loy Kok Institute of Taoism, together with its affiliates around the world, have trained volunteer instructors offering Taoist Tai Chi practise continuously for 50 years and currently offer it to more than 11,000 participants in more than 330 locations in Canada with 1,2000 instructors; and*

WHEREAS *The Fung Loy Kok Institute of Taoism and its affiliates practice the Taoist Tai Chi arts as a path to ultimate transformation, using the guiding principles of compassion, virtue and wisdom in all we do.*

THEREFORE I, Stephen McNeil, Premier of Nova Scotia, do hereby proclaim November 7, 2020 to be "**Taoist Tai Chi Arts 50th Anniversary Day**" in the Province of Nova Scotia, and encourage all Nova Scotians to recognize Fung Loy Kok's remarkable journey of 50 years.
